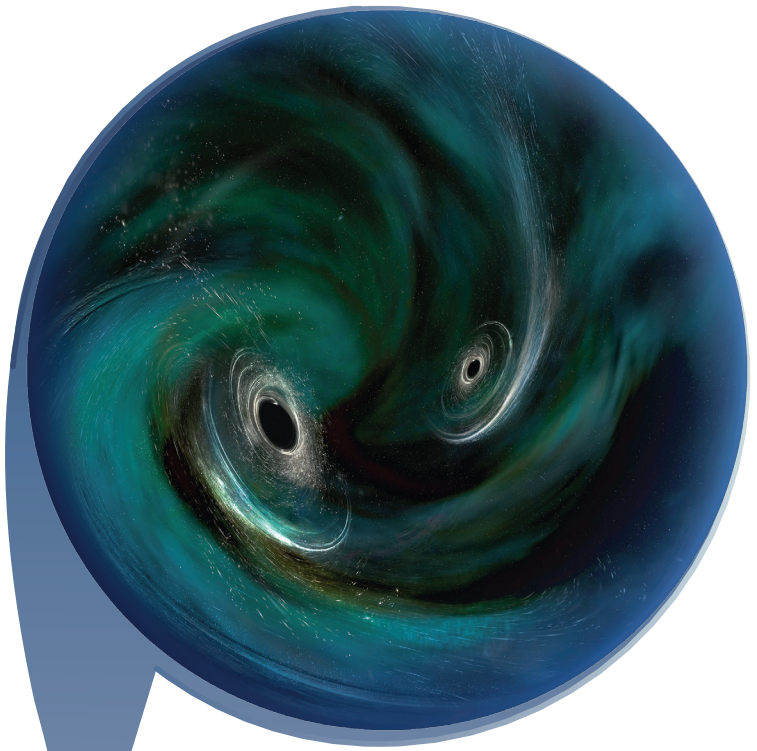


# Listening to Einstein's Universe
